Indian Coast Guard celebrates its 45th Raising Day on 01 February 2021

The Indian Coast Guard (ICG) is celebrating its 45th Raising Day on 01 February 2021. The ICG was formally established on February 1, 1977, by the Coast Guard Act, 1978 of the Parliament of India. It operates under the Ministry of Defence.

World Wetlands Day is observed on 02 February

The World Wetlands Day is observed every year on February 2 globally. The day is celebrated to mark the date of the adoption of the Convention on Wetlands on February 2, 1971, in the Iranian city of Ramsar on the shores of the Caspian Sea. World Wetlands Day was first celebrated in 1997. 2021 marks 50 years of the Convention on Wetlands. The international theme for World Wetlands Day 2021 is 'Wetlands and Water'.

World Cancer Day is observed on February 4

World Cancer Day is observed every year on 4 February by the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC). Purpose of the day is to raise awareness and education about cancer, and pressing governments and individuals across the world to take action against the disease. Biggest Aero show of Asia to begin in Bengaluru

Asia's biggest Aero show will kickstart in Bengaluru. Defence Minister Rajnath Singh will inaugurate the three-days mega Aero India show i.e. taking place for the first time in a hybrid mode due to COVID Pandemic. For the first time Defence Ministers of Indian Ocean region from 27 countries will participate in person or through virtual mode in a conclave organised on the sidelines to discuss shared threats and cooperation in disaster management.

Varanasi receives second cruise boat under PRASAD scheme

Prime Minister Narendra Modi's parliamentary constituency, Varanasi in Uttar Pradesh, received the second cruise boat under the Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Augmentation Drive (PRASAD) scheme of the Central Government. This two-tier cruise boat will run in waters of Ganga river and show the tourists the spectacular view of 84 ghats of Kashi. State tourism Minister Neelkanth Tiwari received the cruise at Ravidas Ghat. He said that it will help in promoting the tourism sector of the city.

Uttarakhand sets up Botanical Garden to conserve 210 species of trees of Shivalik range

In Nainital district of Uttarakhand, a first of its kind botanical garden named 'Shivalik Arboretum' has been inaugurated, for conserving over 210 species of trees found in the Shivalik range of Himalayas. Shivalik Arboretum aims to spread nature education among people so that they are able to feel an emotional connection with the trees, and make them more active towards conservation.

Maharashtra tops 2nd India Justice Report for delivering justice to people

Maharashtra has retained its top rank in the second edition of the India Justice Report – 2020, which judges states in terms of delivery of justice to people. Maharashtra retained its number one position among 18 large and mid -sized states (where population is over one crore each). Tamil Nadu and Telangana were second and third respectively in the same category. Among the 7 small states (where the population is less than one crore each), Tripura has topped the list followed by Sikkim and Goa.

MSME wing of Gol to cooperate in setting up industries up to 20 crore rupees in Dhanbad

In Jharkhand, the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, MSME wing of the Government of India will cooperate in setting up industries up to 20 crore rupees in Dhanbad. Addressing a meeting with the industrialists and members of Dhanbad Chamber and Industrial Organizations, MSME Director Dr. SK Sahu said that the central government will give 70 percent amount, while the remaining 30 percent is to be borne by the state government and industrialists.

The UT had reported a total of 4,932 cases and 62 deaths from the virus.

Delhi CM Arvind Kejriwal today launched 'Delhi Switch' campaign to make people aware of clean vehicles. He appealed to people to buy such vehicles to combat pollution in the city. Speaking at the event, he said that his government's vision is that 25% of new vehicles must be electric by 2024. He said this at the 'Delhi Switch' campaign.

CM Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurates first heliport of Assam in Majuli district

Assam Chief Minister Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurated the first heliport of the state in Majuli district. The heliport having facility for simultaneous landing of three helicopters was constructed at an expenditure of Rs 50 lakh.

Odisha's Balasore to get country's first thunderstorm research testbed

Odisha's Balasore will get the country's first thunderstorm research testbed, the India Meteorological Department (IMD). The objective of setting up the thunderstorm testbed is to minimize human fatalities and loss of property due to lightning strikes. Balasore's Chandipur has the Integrated Test Range for launching missiles.

Himachal Pradesh becomes first State to implement e-cabinet

Himachal Pradesh has become the first State in the country to make the end to end processing of the cabinet paperless by implementing e-cabinet application. Chief Minister Jai Ram Thakur inaugurated the first e-cabinet at Shimla. The e-cabinet application is also available as a Mobile App on android devices.

To reduce the death rate due to pneumonia among infants a strategy is being chalked out under the Social awareness campaign in which medical staff is being trained. Training will be imparted at the community and primary health centres. Around 4,000 Health and Wellness Centres have been set up in Madhya Pradesh for this purpose.

Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) has successfully commissioned the second unit (800 MW) of the 2x800 MW Gadarwara Super Thermal Power Project Stage-I. BHEL has commissioned 24 sets of supercritical boilers and 20 sets of supercritical turbine generators.

Government to launch PLI scheme for air-conditioner, LED lights on 1 April

The commerce and industry ministry will formally launch the production linked incentive (PLI) scheme for air conditioner and LED lights, worth ₹6,238 crore, on 1 April after the finance ministry's nod to the proposal.

Ayesha Aziz becomes India's Youngest Female Pilot at 25

Ayesha Aziz, a 25-year-old from Kashmir has become the youngest female pilot in the country. In 2011, Ayesha Aziz had become the youngest Student pilot to get a license at the age of 15. She underwent training to fly a MIG-29 jet at Russia's Sokol airbase the following year.

Centre grants permission to raise additional five thousand 34 crore rupees through Open Market Borrowings to four states

Government said that four more states Assam, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh and Punjab have been granted permission to raise additional five thousand 34 crore rupees through Open Market Borrowings. The Finance Ministry said, these states have undertaken Ease of Doing Business reforms stipulated by the Department of Expenditure and have become eligible to mobilise additional financial resources.

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

World Bank to provide USD 500 million to Bangladesh for improving Road and Digital Connectivity

The government of Bangladesh signed an agreement with the World Bank for the upgradation of rural roads and connectivity in the western region on Monday. The project is expected to benefit over 20 million people in the western region of Bangladesh. The project will help upgrade the 48 kilometre two-lane Jessore-Jhenaidah road to a modern 4-lane highway. It will also help improve 600 kilometre of connecting rural roads and build or develop new rural markets. The project will finance installation of fiber-optic cables along the highway to ensure fast and reliable internet service, said the World Bank Press release.

Nguyen Phu Trong re-elected as Chief of ruling Communist Party of Vietnam for 3rd term

The ruling Community Party of Vietnam has re-elected its 76-year-old General Secretary Nguyen Phu Trong for a third five-year term. He has been serving the post since 2011. Trong was granted an exemption to contest in the election, though he was above the age limit of 65.

Myanmar military announces new State Administrative Council

The regime in Myanmar headed by the Army has announced a new State Administrative Council. The council headed by the Army Chief General Min Aung Hlaing has eleven members out of which eight are from the military.

US extends New START Nuclear Arms Control Treaty with Russia for five years

The United States has extended the New START (Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty) nuclear arms control treaty with Russia for five years. Announcing the move, US Secretary of State Antony Blinken said it made the world safer. The treaty, which first went into effect in 2011, limits the United States and Russia to deploying no more than 1,550 strategic nuclear warheads each and imposes restrictions on the land- and submarine-based missiles and bombers to deliver them.

India & Bahrain join hands for Renewable Energy

India and Bahrain have agreed to forge deeper engagement in the field of renewable energy. The Joint Working Group in the field of Renewable Energy which held its first meeting in virtual format, underscored the importance of renewable energy to meet climate change goals. A Memorandum of Understanding was signed in July 2018 between India and Bahrain for promoting bilateral cooperation in the field of Renewable Energy.

14th International Children's Film festival concludes in Bangladesh

The 14th International Children's Film Festival of Bangladesh (ICFFB) came to an end in Dhaka. 179 films from 37 countries were shown at various venues during the 7-day long festival organised by the Children's Film Society (CFS) of Bangladesh. Apart from Bangladesh, films from India, Armenia, US, UK, Ireland, Japan and China among others were shown in the course of the festival.

World's First 'Energy Island' to be built by Denmark in North Sea

The Government of Denmark has approved a project to build the world's first energy island, in the North Sea that will produce and store enough green energy to meet the electricity needs of three million households in European countries. The first-of-its-kind giant island will be as big as 18 football pitches (120,000sq m).

2.3 billion transactions worth Rs 4.2 trillion recorded through UPI in January 2021

The Unified Payment Interface recorded 2.3 billion transactions worth Rs 4.3 trillion rupees in January 2021. On a Year-on-year basis, The Unified Payment Interface's transaction value jumped 76.5 percent; while transaction value jumped nearly 100 per cent. First one billion UPI transactions per month took 3 years to cross but the next billion had come in less than a year.

RBI projects GDP at 10.5 percent in 2021-22

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) said that the monetary policy review has decided to continue with an accommodative stance of monetary policy to maintain status quo on key policy rates. This will continue as long as necessary at least through the current financial year and into next year to revive growth and mitigate the impact of Covid 19. The repo rate is kept unchanged at 4 percent and the reverse repo rate at 3.35 percent. RBI governor Shaktikant Das said that the GDP growth is projected at 10.5 percent in the Financial Year 2021-22. He said projection of CPI inflation has been revised to 5.2 percent for the fourth quarter of the current financial year.

RBI to set up a 24x7 helpline for digital payment services

RBI has announced certain measures of protection of common bank account holders in today's Monetary policy statement. It includes setting up of 24*7 helpline for digital payment services, integrated ombudsman scheme, CTS across all bank branches and allowing retail investors to open Gilt accounts with RBI. RBI is also considering the facility of registering and resolving the customer complaints through the helpline.

RBI announces integrated ombudsman scheme for bank customers

The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) announced an integrated ombudsman scheme to improve grievance redressal mechanism for bank customers. The scheme will be rolled out in June. Currently, there are three separate ombudsman for banks, non-banking finance companies and non-bank prepaid payment issuers that are wallets. RBI plans to integrate these under one centralised scheme.

ICICI Bank signs MoU with Japan's MUFG Bank

ICICI Bank today announced the signing of a MoU with MUFG Bank, Japan's premier bank, for collaboration towards catering to the banking requirements of Japanese corporations present in India. The MoU was signed at a virtual event by Vishakha Mulye, Executive Director, ICICI Bank and Junsuke Koike, Executive Officer and Regional Executive for India and Sri Lanka, MUFG Bank, in the presence of senior officials of both banks.

Fiscal deficit pegged at 6.8 percent of GDP

The Fiscal deficit for the financial year 2021-22 pegged at 6.8 percent. The Total resources being transferred to the states including the devolution of states share, grants, loans and releases under centrally sponsored scheme in budget estimate for the fiscal is 13 lakh 88 thousand 502 crore rupees which shows an increase of 74 thousand 565 crores over revised estimate of 2020-21.

Reliance Industries gets world's first 'carbon-neutral' oil from US

Mukesh Ambani's Reliance Industries Ltd has sourced the world's first consignment of 'carbon-neutral oil' from the US as it looks to become a net zero-carbon company by 2035.

SEBI bars Future Group CEO Kishore Biyani from accessing securities market for 1 year

Markets regulator Sebi has barred Future Group CEO Kishore Biyani and his brother Anil from accessing securities market for a period of 1 year in a case pertaining to alleged insider trading between March and April 2017.

India's Forex reserves jump by 4.85 billion dollars to record high of 590.18 billion dollars

The country's foreign exchange reserves rose by 4.85 billion US Dollars to touch a record high of 590.18 billion dollars in the week ended January 29. Forex reserves rose on account of an increase in foreign currency assets (FCA), a major component of the overall reserves. FCA increased by 5.03 billion dollars to 547.22 billion dollars.

Finance Minister holds bilateral meeting with UK's Secretary of State for International Trade

UK Secretary of State for International Trade Mary Elizabeth Truss met Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman in New Delhi. Ms Truss congratulated India for a forward-looking modern budget with its focus on investments and recovery in the post COVID-19 world. She acknowledged India as an influential player in FinTech, Digital Economy, Start-ups, Innovation and Data. ISRO to launch iBrazilian, Indian startup satellite in first mission of 2021

India's space agency Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is planning to launch Brazilian satellite Amazonia-1 and three Indian payloads on 28 February in its first mission of 2021. The satellites, including one built by a home-grown start-up, are slated to be launched on board the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) C-51 at 10.24 am from the Sriharikota spaceport, said K Sivan, the secretary in the Department of Space and Chairman of Bengaluru-headquartered ISRO.

Tamil Nadu beat Baroda by 7 wickets to lift second Syed Mushtaq Ali T20 Trophy

Tamil Nadu lifted the coveted Syed Mushtaq Ali T20 Trophy after defeating Baroda by seven wickets in the final at the Sardar Patel Stadium in Ahmedabad. This was Tamil Nadu's second Syed Mushtaq Ali Trophy (SMAT) triumph, after winning their first title way back in 2006-07. Baroda, who had won the title twice in the past (in 2011-12 and 2013-14), ended runners-up this time. It was a clinical campaign for Tamil Nadu who remained unbeaten throughout the league. Chasing 121 to win, they overhauled the target in 18 overs with 7 wickets to spare.

Former pacer Merv Hughes inducted into Australian Cricket Hall of Fame

Former right-arm fast bowler Merv Hughes has been inducted into the Australian Cricket Hall of Fame. The 59-year-old played 53 Tests and 33 ODIs for Australia in a career spanning from 1985 to 1994, during which he captured 212 Test wickets and 38 ODI wickets.

India ranked 53rd in EIU's Democracy Index, Norway Tops

India's position has slipped by two places to be placed at 53rd spot in the 2020 Democracy Index, from among 167 countries. Democracy Index is the global ranking released by The Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU) that provides a snapshot of the current state of democracy worldwide. The overall score of India is 6.61 in the Index, on a scale of 0-10. Norway has topped the Index.

Christopher Plummer, oldest Oscar winner in his 80s, Passed Away
