Zero Discrimination Day is observed on March 1

The Zero Discrimination Day is held every year on 1 March. Purpose of the day is to ensure right to equality, inclusion and protection of all people without any discrimination in their law and policies to live a full life with dignity regardless of any barriers. The Day was launched by UNAIDS in 2014. Theme of Zero Discrimination Day 2021 is "End Inequalities"

45th Civil Accounts Day celebrated on March 1

The 45th Civil Accounts Day was celebrated in New Delhi on 1 March. Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman was the Chief Guest of the event. Comptroller and Auditor General G.C. Murmu, Expenditure Secretary Dr T. V. Somanathan and Controller General of Accounts Soma Roy Burman were present on the occasion among others.

3rd Jan Aushadhi Diwas celebrations begins on March 1

STATE NEWS

"Gharoki Pechan, Chelik Naam" Scheme launched in Nainital

Mumbai's CSMT becomes first railway station to get IGBC Gold Certification

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus Railway Station of Central Railway is the first railway station in Maharashtra to be awarded with Gold certification as per CII's Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) ratings. Central Railway has implemented various green initiatives across its zone, with plantations creating green areas, installation of solar panels, customer-friendly initiatives at many stations, LED bulbs and lights etc.

Nagaland launches its first air cargo services from Dimapur airport

Nagaland yesterday launched its first air cargo services from Dimapur airport. Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio officially flagged off the service, a joint initiative of Department of Horticulture, Nagaland and Airport Authority of India with Air India and Indigo as airline partners.

Bengaluru and Shimla among 'Most liveable' cities across country

Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs Hardeep Singh Puri announced the release of the final rankings of Ease of Living Index-2020 and the Municipal Performance Index-2020 in New Delhi in an online event. Bengaluru emerged as the top performer in the Million Plus category, followed by Pune, Ahmedabad, Chennai, Surat, Navi Mumbai, Coimbatore, Vadodara, Indore and Greater Mumbai. In the Less than Million category, Shimla was ranked the highest in ease of living, followed by Bhubaneshwar, Silvassa, Kakinada, Salem, Vellore, Gandhinagar, Gurugram, Davangere and Tiruchirappalli.

Two-day Gur Mahotsav underway in Lucknow

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

Israel officially receives first ever UAE ambassador

Israel's president formally received the first-ever ambassador from the United Arab Emirates, following last year's historic agreement between the countries to normalise ties. UAE envoy Mohamed Al Khaja delivered his credentials to Israeli President Reuven Rivlin at a ceremony in Jerusalem. The UAE was the first country to agree to establish full diplomatic relations with the Jewish state under the Abraham Accords, a pact brokered by former US president Donald Trump.

Sri Lanka approves new port development with India and Japan

Sri Lanka's government will allow India and Japan to develop a new container terminal at the country's main port, several weeks after scrapping a deal with the two countries to develop one of the key terminals at the same port.

US imposes fresh sanctions against Russia over Navalny issue

The United States has slapped sanctions on Russian individuals and entities over the near-fatal poisoning of prominent opposition figure Alexei Navalny with a nerve agent. Speaking to reporters, the senior White House officials said the sanctions were being imposed in coordination with the European Union, and urged the release of Navalny from prison.

Bangladesh launches national app portal

The Government of Bangladesh has launched its national app portal bdapps.com. The agreement between the ICT division of the government of Bangladesh and the telecom company Robi was signed in Dhaka. BDApps will be established as the hub of the ICT division for application developers. Under the agreement, the ICT division will collaborate with bdapps to organise exclusive boot camps and software development events in the country.

1st consignment of 'red rice' flagged off to US

In a major boost to India's rice exports potential, the first consignment of 'red rice' was flagged off today to the US. Iron rich 'red rice' is grown in Brahmaputra valley of Assam, without the use of any chemical fertilizer. The rice variety is referred as 'Bao-dhaan', which is an integral part of Assamese food.

EAM Dr. Jaishankar inaugurates new Cultural Centre of High Commission of India in Dhaka

A new cultural centre of the High Commission of India was inaugurated by the External Affairs Minister Dr. S. Jaishankar in Dhaka. It is the second cultural centre of the High Commission of India after the Dhanmondi centre at the Indira Gandhi Cultural Centre in Dhaka. The new cultural centre has facilities for conducting short term courses on Indian art forms and holding cultural programmes and art-exhibitions.













PM Modi to inaugurate 'Maitri Setu' between India & Bangladesh

Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate Maitri Setu between India and Bangladesh through video conferencing. Mr Modi will also inaugurate and lay the foundation stone of multiple infrastructure projects in Tripura during the event. The bridge Maitri Setu has been built over Feni river which flows between Indian boundary in Tripura State and Bangladesh. The name Maitri Setu symbolizes growing bilateral relations and friendly ties between India and Bangladesh.

Bangladesh's first transgender newsreader appointed

A private news channel has appointed Bangladesh's first transgender news presenter. Tashnuva Anan Shishir will start presenting news for Boishakhi TV from the International Women's Day on March 8. This was announced on Friday by the TV news channel. The TV channel has appointed another transgender Nusrat Mau as one of the main characters for the regular drama section of the TV channel's entertainment wing.

NPCI Partners SBI Payments to launch "RuPay SoftPoS" for Merchants

National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) and SBI Payments have partnered to launch "RuPay SoftPoS" for Indian merchants. RuPay SoftPoS will enable merchants to use their near-field communication (NFC)-enabled smartphones as point of sale (PoS) terminals and accept payment up to Rs 5,000 through a simple tap and pay mechanism.
